The date of the vaccinations for each school is clearly marked on your child’s consent form. Once your student is vaccinated they will receive a “Healthy Hero” wrist band and the proper paper work will be sent to you for your records. There is no out of pocket expense for you and your student will be better protected against the flu this flu season!
